On December 12, 2006, this Court approved and entered a *Revised Consent Decree Approving Entry of Partial Decrees Determining the Rights of the United States as Trustee for the Benefit of the Shoshone-Paiute Tribes to the Use of Water in the Snake River Basin within Idaho* (“*Consent Decree*”). According to the terms of the *Consent Decree* the above-captioned claims were withdrawn and intended to be decreed disallowed by the Court.

THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the above-captioned water rights (included on attached list of 24 claims) are hereby **disallowed with prejudice** and shall not be confirmed in any partial decree or in any final decree entered in the SRBA, Case No. 39576, in whatever form that final decree may take or be styled.
